<b>Dundee Instrumental Band</b>	...Dundee Instrumental Band is the city's oldest surviving brass band, originally called St. Margaret's it has a history dating back more than 100 years. Playing modern classics and the songs from the big band era...
<b>The Woodlands Dance Orchestra</b>	...plays the Big Band sounds, from original swing music of the 30's and 40's, through to contemporary pop music, including vocals...
<b>Steamer Lane</b>	...vocal/instrumental group. Feature harmonics and original songs...
<b>Clydebuilt Puppets</b>	...Red Riding Hood's Magic Purse – A classic Story told with a difference. Favourite characters abound, an adventurous Red Riding Hood and Independent Granny (Home at last from her trip around the world) and of course the wonderful, Wicked Wolf who plans to eat "Grannie for Lunch and Little Rosie for afternoon Tea"...
<b>Dundee Floral Art Club</b>	...embarking on its 52 <sup>nd</sup> year. The club was originally formed to promote the idea of "friendship through flowers". The Club meets in the Queens Hotel, usually on the third Wednesday of the month at 2.30pm and 7.30pm, the first meeting of the new session is on 17 <sup>th</sup> September 2008...
