- Dogs** – No dogs other than guide/hearing dogs will be admitted to the showground
- First Aid** – Situated in the central showground. St Andrews Ambulance is providing the First Aid Team (wheelchairs available on the day on a first-come, first-served basis)
- Information** – Call at the Information Caravan, situated in the main entrance arena
- Lost Children** – Lost children should be taken to the Information Caravan, in the main entrance arena
- Catering** – The Catering Marquee is adjacent to the Main Marquee, offering teas, coffees, snacks and main meals.
East & West Food Court – A variety of catering outlets offering teas, coffees, soft drinks and a range of sandwiches and takeaway food. All outdoor catering is supplied by Country Refreshments, Lanark
- Telephone** – For emergency calls only. Contact the Festival Office, situated by the main entrance. Public announcements will be made as appropriate
