

Comfort Teddy Pattern (Class 973)

You will need:

Size 11 (3mm) knitting needles
Double knitting in fawn or browns for head and paws,
Bright colours for jumper, trousers and scarf.
Washable toy stuffing (not foam or rags)
Leave ends for sewing up.

Legs, body and head:

Cast on 10 stitches in fawn and knit 10 rows

Continue in trouser colour and knit 30 rows
Make another leg the same
Knit across all 20 stitches and work 16 rows

Change to jumper colour and knit 24 rows
Change to fawn and stocking stitch for head
Continue until head measures 5½ inches

Change to jumper colour and knit 24 rows
Change to trouser colour and knit 16 rows
On 10 stitches knit 30 rows of trouser colour and 10 rows of fawn.
Cast off the 10 stitches, rejoin yarn to the other 10 stitches and complete the other leg to match

Arms:

Stitch down the sides of the head
With jumper colour pick up 8 stitches either side of the neck join (16 stitches in all)
Knit 20 rows
Change to fawn and knit 10 rows for paws
Make second arm



To Make Up:

Sew up teddy, right sides together and leave an opening at crotch. Turn right side out. Sew across top corners to make ears
Stuff
Sew a running stitch round neck to draw it in
Sew a happy face in back stitch and satin stitch

Scarf

Cast on 75 stitches and knit 4 rows. Cast off
Tie scarf on teddy and catch down at back of neck close to jumper edge

Well done! Your teddy will bring a smile to a child's face
