

E FLORAL ART SECTION

Closing date for Floral Art entries - Tuesday 27 August 2019. All exhibits will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual (3rd Edition 2015), with the exception of Classes 710, 711 and 712.

An exhibit is composed of natural plant material with or without accessories contained within a space as specified. Plant material must predominate in all exhibits unless otherwise stated. All fresh plant material must be in water or water-retaining material apart from the permitted exceptions.

Unless otherwise stated, all exhibits will be staged on tabling 75 cm from the ground in the allowed space: width 80 cm, depth 70 cm, height 100 cm.

All staging will be covered in light green fabric. All drapes and backgrounds must be free-standing and nothing may be attached to the staging.

Please note all exhibits must be assembled **at the competition**, with the exception of Classes 709, 710, 711 and 712, which will be considered as Craft Classes.
