Maximum points allowed for each kind of vegetable:-

Beetroot, long; carrots, long; cauliflowers; celery, trench; leeks;  
 onions, large exhibition; parsnips; peas; potatoes ..... 20 points  
 Aubergine, beans, runner; carrots, other than long; celery,  
 self blanching; cucumbers; shallots, large exhibition; tomatoes ... 18 points  
 Beans, broad or dwarf french/stringless; beetroot, globe;  
 cabbages; marrows; onions, from sets or under 250g, turnips .... 15 points

The number of points will be placed on each exhibit.
